CHALLENGE

This lesson is used for you to better understand the Word, to evaluate the fruitfulness of your own walk and to help you choose what role you want to play in the Harvest.

“The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.”



Read aloud Mark 4:1-9.



Repeat these question for each 4 of the soil conditions.

- Who is the sower?
- What is the seed?
- What is the first soil condition?
- What do you think it represents?

(just ask the questions, do not correct their answers)

Read aloud to you Mark 4:10-20.

- Have them answer the same questions as before.
- Make sure they understand each of the 4 soil conditions as you go through it.



Lastly, review the 4 soils and answer the following questions,

- Of these 4 soils, which soil best represents your life?
- Which soil would you like to have represent your life?
- Lastly, if they answered that they would like to have the good soil, ask if they would be willing to meet on a regular basis so that you can help them have it.
